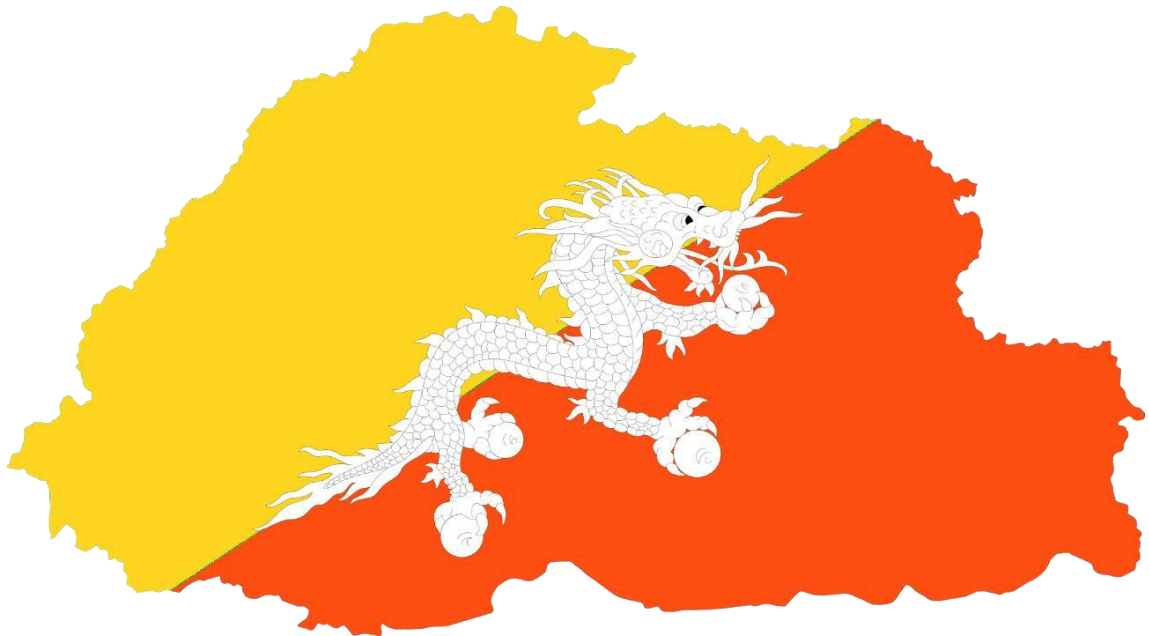

Bhutan often referred to as 'Land of the Thunder Dragon' or 'the last Shangri La' on earth, is situated in the lap of Eastern Himalayas between India and the People's Republic of China. Covering an area of 38,394 sq km, the tiny Himalayan Kingdom is one of the most isolated nations in the world. It is in the relatively unexplored pockets of Asia, which allows only a limited number of discerning travelers to preserve its fragile environment and culture in its magical purity.

This country of rolling hills and deep crags exudes immense charm. 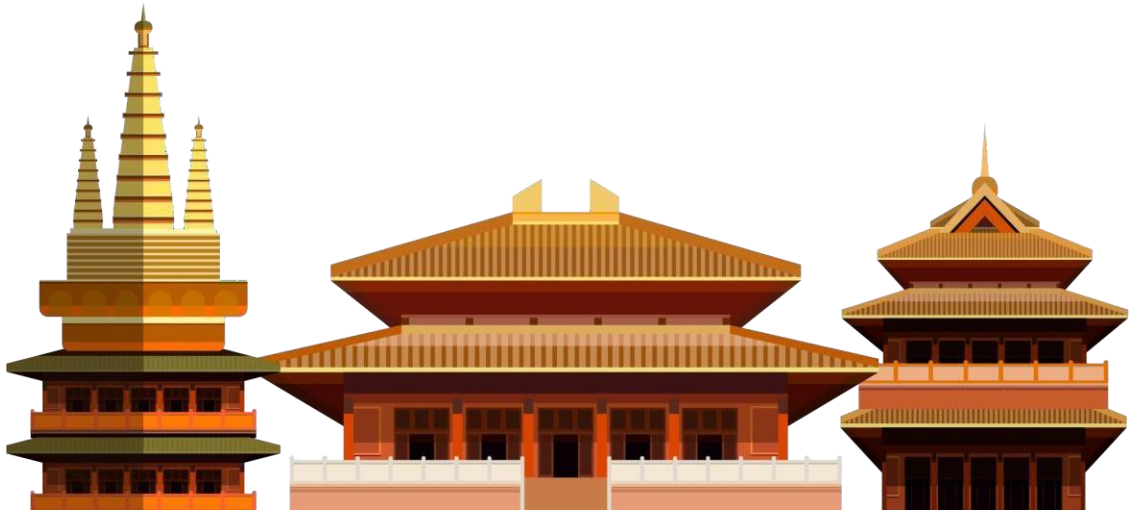

DAY 1 – BAGDOGRA(IXB) / NEW JALPAIGUTI (NJP) TO PHUNTSHOLIN TRANSFER (OVER NIGHT STAY AT PHUENTSHOLING).

DAY 2 – PHUNTSHOLING TO THIMPHU ON THE WAY SIGHTSEING (NIGHT STAY AT THIMPHU).

Day 3 – THIMPHU TO PUNAKHA LOCAL SIGHTSEEING (NIGHT STAY AT THIMPHU)

DAY 3 – THIMPHU TO PARO VIA LOCAL SIGHT SEEING (NIGHT STAY AT PARO).

DAY 4 – PARO TIGER'S NEST (NIGHT STAY AT PARO).

DAY 5 – PARO TO BAGDOGRA (IXB)/ NEW JALPAIGURI (NJP) – End of the Trip.

DAY 1: Bagdogra (IXB) / New Jalpaigiri (NJP) to Phuentsholing. *Travel time: 4:00 to 5:00 hr (142.6 km).*

- Upon your arrival at the airport or station, our representative will warmly welcome them and ensure their safe transfer to Phuentsholing, the charming border town of Bhutan. The journey from Siliguri takes approximately 3.5 hours, along a scenic route that weaves through lush tea plantations and serene national parks, creating a picturesque and peaceful experience.
- By evening, they will reach the border, where Bhutan's unique charm becomes immediately apparent. Stepping into Bhutan is like entering a different world—calm, orderly, and culturally rich. The towns on either side of the border tell two distinct stories, and your child will find themselves in an environment known for its safety, serenity, and respect for tradition.
- **Overnight stay at Phuentsholing border.**



DAY 2: Phuentsholing to Thimphu

Travel time: 4 hr (145.6 km).

- After a hearty breakfast, you will prepare for their onward journey to Thimphu, Bhutan's vibrant capital city. With their luggage ready, our representative will assist in completing the immigration formalities, ensuring a smooth process. Following this, your child will embark on a scenic drive, surrounded by breathtaking mountain views and unforgettable moments along the way.
- The journey includes a visit to the serene Gedu Stupa, a stop for a delightful lunch, and an opportunity to marvel at the Wangkha waterfalls. Each stretch of the journey showcases the beauty and tranquility of the Bhutanese countryside, offering a warm introduction to the Land of the Thunder Dragon.
- By evening, your child will explore Thimphu city with a guided walk around the iconic Clock Tower Square and its surroundings. This captivating cityscape reflects Bhutan's harmonious blend of tradition and modernity.

Day 3: Thimphu Sightseeing

Travel time: 1:30 min, 50 km (Thimphu to Paro).

Pack your backpack(luggage) and enjoy a hearty breakfast to start the day. Today, we'll guide you through Thimphu's fascinating local attractions, We'll spend the day exploring the wonderful sights of Thimphu. By evening, we'll head to Paro for a cozy night's rest, so you're refreshed and ready for more adventures tomorrow!".

- **Simtokha Dzong**

One of Bhutan's oldest fortresses, it now serves as a center for cultural studies and Buddhist teachings.

- **Traditional Medicine Institute**

A fascinating place where ancient Bhutanese healing practices using herbal medicines are preserved and practiced.

- **Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang)**

Home to the giant Buddha Dordenma statue, offering stunning views of Thimphu and a serene environment.

- **Trashichhoedzong**

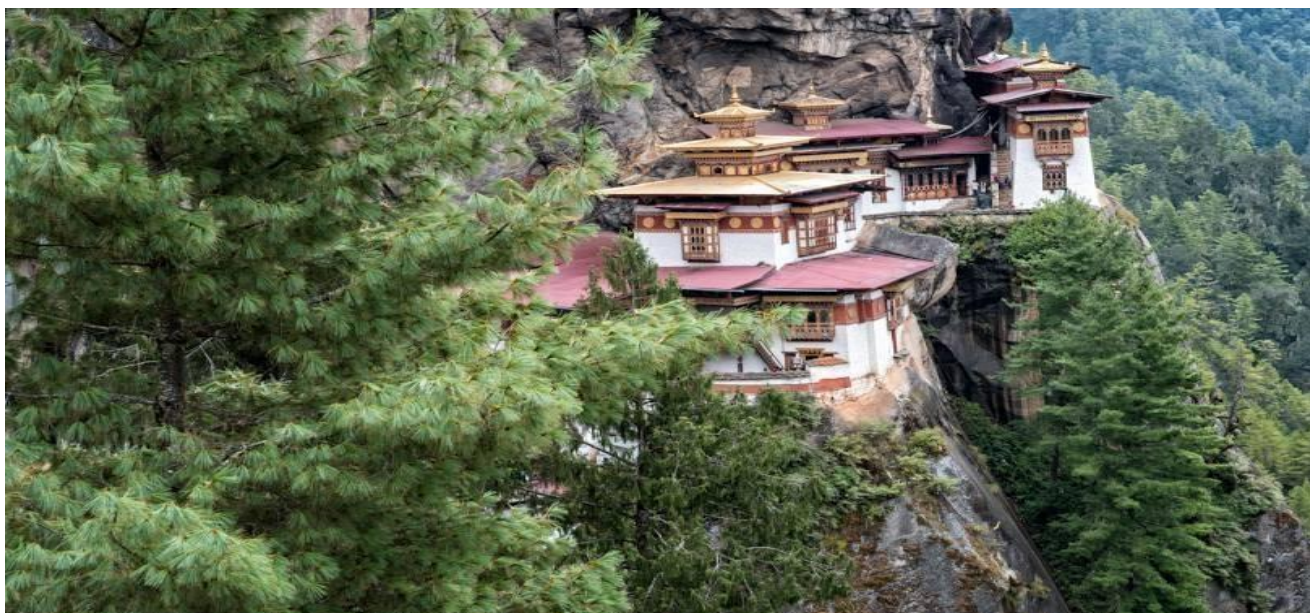
An impressive fortress and monastery that serves as the seat of Bhutan's government and the summer residence of the monk body.

- **Simply Bhutan Museum**

An interactive museum that immerses visitors in Bhutanese culture, offering activities like archery and traditional dance.

(If time allows, we will also visit the Takin Preservation Centre. This open zoo is home to Bhutan's unique national animal, the Takin, which is one of the most endangered species in the world and found only in Bhutan.)

Over night stay at Paro.



Day 4: Hike to Tiger's Nest

Hike time: Around 6 to 7 hours, altitude: 3,120 m, 6.4 km.

Pack your backpack for an exciting day ahead! After an early breakfast, we'll set off for the iconic hike to Tiger's Nest, also known as Taktsang Monastery.

- The trail winds gently through beautiful pine forests and colorful rhododendron trees, with plenty of chances to rest and take in the stunning mountain views. Reaching Tiger's Nest is not just a walk—it's an incredible experience that combines nature's beauty with a touch of spiritual wonder. You're going to love every step of it!
- Once we reach the top of Tiger's Nest, get ready for an amazing view of the Bhutanese mountains! You'll be able to take in the breathtaking beauty of Mother Nature—rolling hills, lush forests, and the peaceful surroundings that make Bhutan so special. It's truly a sight you'll remember forever!
- After completing the hike, we'll make our way back down and head to the hotel to relax and unwind. You can choose to explore the vibrant Paro market, or simply enjoy some downtime at your hotel, taking in the peaceful surroundings.

Your overnight stay will be in Paro, so you can rest up for another day.



Day 5: Paro to Bagdogra Airport drop

Travel time: 7:00 to 8:00 hr (307.8 km).

- The journey from Paro to Bagdogra typically starts with a drive from Paro to the Phuentsholing border, which takes about 3 to 4 hours by road. The route is scenic, passing through hills and valleys, and is generally comfortable with a private vehicle or tourist bus. It's recommended to start early in the morning to reach the border by afternoon.
- At Phuentsholing, travelers must complete the Bhutan exit formalities and Indian immigration entry process. This usually takes around 30 minutes, depending on the queue. After crossing the border, it's a 4 to 5-hour drive to Bagdogra Airport. Overall, the entire journey takes approximately 8 to 9 hours, including stops and immigration time.
